

INFORMATION CONCERNING THE HIGHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS THAT ACCEPT FOREIGN STUDENTS

A. HOW TO READ THE TABLE

Table - 1 is made up of four columns; in the first column are the code numbers of the higher education programs; in the second column are the names of these programs; in the third column are special notes for the programs and in the fourth column the total number of students to be admitted is shown.

For "see 1", "see 2", etc. the section below headed "D. SPECIAL REGULATIONS CONCERNING TABLE-1" should be referred to. If there are no asterisks (*) or (**) placed beside the name of a higher education program then that program is of 4 years duration.

B. IMPORTANT REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE TABLE

1. The candidate should apply to the university for the programs for which he/she meets all the requirements. Candidates should take careful note of the requirements of a program and should not apply for a program to which they do not have the necessary requirements.
2. In selecting a program you are advised to ensure that you possess the aptitude and skills necessary to enter this program.
3. If a program in this table is, for any reason, either not opened or discontinued, application made for that program will be disregarded.
4. Should a specific program coded in this Guide receive a change of name or be attached to a different institution of higher education, students accepted in that program will be required to abide by the regulations relating to the new conditions.

D. SPECIAL REGULATIONS CONCERNING TABLE-1

- see 1. When selecting a program, the candidate must have no physical or psychological defects that might affect a career in the field chosen. Students who have been selected according to the rules and regulations covering this guide may be asked to submit a health report verifying the above, at the time of registration.
- see 2. The students who are registered in this program, must wear uniforms in the applied courses.
- see 3. Only female students can apply.
- see 4. For students wishing to follow a one-year Preparatory Course in German with a quota, there is an additional year of study. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation.
- see 5. There is a compulsory one-year Preparatory Course in English or French. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation.
- see 6. For students wishing to follow a one-year Preparatory Course in English with a quota, there is an additional year of study. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation.
- see 7. In this program all students are required to study English in their foreign language class.
- see 8. The candidate must either pass the English Language Proficiency Test of the University or must follow the one-year English Preparatory Course of the institution of higher education in which he/she has been placed. This year of English language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. The English Language Proficiency Test will be organized by the institution of higher education where he/she has been placed.
- see 9. With this program, students who have not been successful in the Preparatory Course may start their undergraduate program, but sometime before they graduate they are required to pass the Proficiency Examination set by the University.
- see10. The candidate must either pass the German Language Proficiency Test of the University or must follow the one-year German Preparatory Course of the institution of higher education in which he/she has been placed. This year of German language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. The German Language Proficiency Test will be organized by the institution of higher education where he/she has been placed.
- see 11. Students who are unsuccessful in the Preparatory Course of this program are dismissed from the University.

see12. The candidate must either pass the French Language Proficiency Test of the University or must follow the one-year French Preparatory Course of the institution of higher education in which he/she has been placed. This year of French language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. The French Language Proficiency Test will be organized by the institution of higher education where he/she has been placed.

see13. In order to register into this program the candidate should have no speech, hearing or sight impairments.

see14. The medium of instruction is English. There is a one-year compulsory English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Students who, within the last two years, have passed the English Proficiency Test set by the University, or have obtained an acceptable score in one of the international examinations recognized by the University (minimum TOEFL-550, TOEFL with computer-213, Cambridge Proficiency-PASS or IELTS-6.5) may register directly into the first year of the programs. Those who pass the English Proficiency Test at the end of the preparatory year are eligible to register into the first year of the program.

see15. At least thirty per cent of the instruction of this course is given in English.

see16. The language of instruction is English.

see17. To be successful in this program, an aesthetic sense, creativity, drawing skills and a feel for design are all essential.

see18. For students wishing to follow a one-year Preparatory Course in foreign languages with a quota, there is an additional year of study. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation.

see19. At registration time, students are required to submit a detailed medical report from a reputable hospital confirming that they have no physical or psychological problems.

see20. The candidate must either pass the Spanish Language Proficiency Test of the University or must follow the one-year Spanish Preparatory Course of the institution of higher education in which he/she has been placed. This year of Spanish Language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. The Spanish Language Proficiency Test will be organized by the institution of higher education where he/she has been placed.

see21. The candidate must either pass the Italian Language Proficiency Test of the University or must follow the one-year Italian Preparatory Course of the institution of higher education in which he/she has been placed. This year of Italian Language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. The Italian Language Proficiency Test will be organized by the institution of higher education where he/she has been placed.

see22. To be successful in this program a strong creative sense of design is essential as are dexterity of the hands and fingers.

see23. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Atılım University are 7 500 US \$. The tuition fee is payable in two installments in Turkish Liras according to the foreign exchange rate of the Central Bank of the Republic of Turkey. The first installment is paid on registration and the second one is paid at the beginning of the second semester.

The language of instruction is English. There is a one-year English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Students who are successful in the English Proficiency Test organized by the University or obtain an acceptable score in one of the examinations (minimum TOEFL 213, IELTS 6.5 or FCE (B) in English Language and Literature and Interpretation and Translation and TOEFL 173, IELTS 6.0, FCE (C) in the other programs) recognized by the University are eligible to register into the first year of the higher education program into which they have been placed. Students who are unable to complete the English Preparatory Course successfully in two consecutive years will be dismissed from the University.

see24. For the 2005-2006 academic year, at Bahçeşehir University tuition fees are 8 000 US \$ for all programs. Every year tuition fees will be increased by a maximum of 5 per cent as US \$.

The language of instruction is English. There is a one-year English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Those who pass the English Proficiency Test held at the start of the academic year or who have passed such an examination as is recognized as equivalent by the University e.g. TOEFL, IELTS, FCE, CPE or TWE may register directly into the programs which they have been placed into.

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Students who are unsuccessful in the English Proficiency Test must follow an intensive Preparatory English Course. Those who pass the English Proficiency Test at the end of the course are eligible to register into the first year of the program in which they have been placed. Students who are unsuccessful in this Preparatory Course in two consecutive years are dismissed from the University.

see25. For the 2005-2006 academic year the tuition fees at Başkent University are 8 000 US \$. Every year tuition fees will be increased by a maximum of 7.5 per cent as US \$.

see26. In the fourth year of their degree programs, in accordance with their success rates, students will take courses in Horticultural Crops, Plant Protection, Field Crops, Soil Sciences, Zootechnique etc.

see27. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Beykent University are for the Preparatory Course 4 000 US \$, for the degree programs 4 900 US \$ equal to Turkish Liras. (Value Added Tax (VAT) not included). The language of instruction is English. There is a one-year English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Students who pass the English Proficiency Test organized by the University or obtain an acceptable score in one of the international examinations (TOEFL or IELTS) recognized by the University register directly into the first year of the higher education program in which they have been placed. Students who are unable to complete the English Preparatory Course successfully in two consecutive years are dismissed from the University.

see28. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Bilkent University are 8 500 US \$. The tuition fee is payable in two installments. For the first installment 4 250 US \$ is paid on registration and for the second one 4 250 US \$ is paid at the beginning of the second semester. Every year tuition fees will be increased by a maximum of 5 percent as US \$. Partial exemption from the tuition fees is granted to those students, from the second year of their studies, who achieve a successful academic performance.

see29. The language of instruction is English. Students are required to prove that their English is satisfactory by passing the University's English Proficiency Examination, or by attaining a satisfactory level in examinations recognized by the University as equivalent (TOEFL, TWE, IELTS, FCE or CPE) or by passing Bilkent's English Proficiency Test. Equivalents of these examinations are valid for a period of two years.

The students who are unsuccessful in the English Proficiency Test or in one of the international examinations, must follow the Supporting and Preparatory Course organized by the University. The students who are unable to complete these courses are dismissed from the University.

If these students are once more accepted by Bilkent University on the results of the Examination for Foreign Students they may enter the English Proficiency Test. The students who are successful in the Examination may register into the program they have been accepted for. If they do not they lose the right of being a student and they are given the space of one year in which to pass one of the international examinations that is recognized as equivalent by the University. If the students who are successful, are eligible to register into the program they have been accepted for. The students must pass such examinations in a year. The students who are successful in the English Preparatory Course, but leave course and then placed in a program are taken in the Language Examination of Bilkent University. After the Examination, according to their level of English, they follow the English Preparatory Course. The students who are unsuccessful in this Preparatory Course are dismissed from the University.

see30. The language of instruction varies according to the requirements of the course, between French and English. In order to commence the program, students must pass the Proficiency Test in both languages. Those who fail to do so must follow a Preparatory Course in English and/or French as necessary.

see31. The language of instruction is English. Foreign students enter the Proficiency Examination organized by the University's School of Foreign Languages. Those who do not pass follow an intensive English Language Course. Those who then pass the Proficiency Test or an international examination such as TOEFL or IELTS that is recognized as equivalent by the University, may then register into their degree course.

see32. Students who successfully complete this program receive a Master Degree without preparing thesis.

see33. The language of instruction is English. There is a one-year compulsory English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Students who pass the English Proficiency Test organized by the University or obtain an acceptable score in one of the international examinations (TOEFL or IELTS) recognized by the University, are eligible to register into the first year of the higher education program into which they have been placed. Those who pass the English Proficiency Test at the end of the preparatory course, may be registered into the program where he/she has been placed.

see34. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Çankaya University are 5 800 US \$. (Value Added Tax (VAT) included.)

see35. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Doğuş University for the degree programs and the Preparatory Course are 7 000 US \$. (Value Added Tax (VAT) included). The tuition fees are payable in two equal installments at the beginning of the Fall and Spring semesters.

see36. The language of instruction is English. The students take the Proficiency Test in English. Those who do not pass the Proficiency Test, must follow the English Preparatory Course. The duration of this course is at most two years. These years are not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. The instruction in one of the Vocational Foreign Language Courses is French.

see37. Students who are unsuccessful in the Preparatory Course, may follow a Supplementary Course in the following year in accordance with the Education Regulations. Students who are unsuccessful in the Supplementary Course may start their undergraduate program, but sometime before graduation they are required to pass the Proficiency Examination set by the University.

see 38. The language of instruction of the programs in the Compulsory Preparatory Course is supported by the foreign language.

see 39. In this program the main language of instruction is Turkish, but in some courses the language of instruction is partially English.

see40. Students who choose this program will have to provide for themselves such aids as video-cassettes, cameras, films, flashes and tape-recorders that may be required for practical courses.

see41. The candidate must either pass the English and German Language Proficiency Tests of the University or must follow the one-year English and German Preparatory Course of the institution of higher education in which he/she has been placed. This year of English and German Language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. The students who pass the Proficiency Test may start the first year of their degree programs directly.

see42. In this program the medium of instruction is Turkish, but in some courses the language is partially German or English.

see43. The students are required to continue their studies at the Istanbul Campus. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Fatih University are for all Preparatory Courses 2 500 US \$ for the Faculty of Sciences and Arts 2 000 US \$, for the Faculty of Engineering and the Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences 3 000 US \$. The tuition fee is payable in eight installments in Turkish Liras according to the foreign exchange rate of the Central Bank of the Republic of Turkey. This does not include the %8 Value Added Tax (VAT) that has to be paid with each installment.

see44. For the 2005-2006 academic year the tuition fees at İzmir Economy University are for all programs 5 750 US \$. (Value Added Tax (VAT) not included). The tuition fees are payable in two equal installments at the beginning of the registration period and at the beginning of the second semester according to the Central Bank of the Republic of Turkey effective foreign exchange offer rate.

see45. —

see46. There is a one-year German Preparatory Course. This year of German language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Those who pass the German Proficiency Test held at the start of the academic year or who have within the last five years passed an examination that is recognized as equivalent by the University e.g. KPDS, PNDS, ZDP or ZMP, are exempted from the Preparatory Course and may register directly into the program they have been accepted into.

see47. In this program the language of Instruction is French. There is a two-year Preparatory Course. In order to register into this program, students must first pass the French Proficiency Test

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organised by the University. Those who do not pass this examination, must register into a one-year French Language Preparatory Course or a one-year "Second Advanced French Preparatory Course and Social Studies Preparatory Course" Students who are successful at the end of the course, then they commence their studies.

see48. The language of instruction is French. Students who have been placed in this program must pass the French Proficiency Test organized by the University. Students whose competence in French falls short of the required standard must follow a French Language Preparatory Course for one year.

see49. The candidate must either pass the Arabic Language Proficiency Test of the University or must follow the one-year Arabic Preparatory Course of the institution of higher education in which he/she has been placed. This year of Arabic language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation.

see50. The language of instruction is French.

see51. The language of instruction is German.

see52. There is a one-year German Preparatory Course. This year of German language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Those who pass the German Proficiency Test held at the start of the academic year or who have within the last five years, passed an examination that is recognized as equivalent by the University e.g. KPDS, PNDS, GDS, KDS, ZDP or ZMP are exempt from the Preparatory Course and may register directly into the program they have been accepted into.

see53. There is a one-year English Preparatory Course. This year of English language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Those who pass the English Proficiency Test held at the start of the academic year or who have, within the last five years passed an examination that is recognized as equivalent by the University e.g. KPDS, TOEFL, IELTS, FCE, CPE or CAE are exempted from the Preparatory Course and may register directly into the program they have been accepted into.

see54. There is a one-year French Preparatory Course. This year of French language training is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Those who pass the French Proficiency Test held at the start of the academic year or who have, within the last five years, passed an examination that is recognized as equivalent by the University e.g. KPDS or DELF, are exempted from the Preparatory Course and may register directly into the program they have been accepted into.

see55. Haliç University was established by the Bizim Lösemili Çocuklar Foundation and it is a trust-endowed University. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees are as follows: for the English Preparatory Course, Turkish Music, Theater at Conservatory, American Culture and Literature 5 000 US \$, for the Psychology 6 000 US \$, for the Molecular Biology and Genetics 6 500 US \$, for the Interior Architecture 6 750 US \$, for the Architecture 6 000 US \$, for the Computer Engineering 7 500 US \$, for the Management (Turkish) and the Tourism Management 6 500 US \$, for the Management (English) 7 500 US \$, for the Graphic and Design 6 750 US \$, for the School of Nursing 2 500 US \$ equal to Turkish Liras. (Value Added Tax (VAT) included). The tuition fees are payable in Fall and Spring semesters on registration. The tuition fees will be increased at most 5 per cent as US \$ in a year.

see56. Işık University was established by Feyziye Mektepleri Foundation (FMV) which dates back roughly 119 years and is Turkey's first Educational Foundation. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Işık University are 10 000 US \$ for all degree programs and preparatory course. (Value Added Tax (VAT) %8 not included). The tuition fees are payable in two installments. The first installment is paid on registration of fall semester and second one is paid in the second spring semester. The prices for accommodation facilities, foods and books are not included.

The language of instruction is English. Students have to demonstrate that their level of English is adequate either they must pass the English Proficiency Test set by Işık University or have passed (within the last two years) such English examinations as TOEFL, TWE, IELTS, FCE or CPE which Işık University regards as equivalent. Students who fail to meet these requirements follow the Preparatory School Course. Those who are not successful are dismissed from the University. The successful ones in the English Proficiency Test commence the program they have been accepted into.

see57. There is a one-year Greek Preparatory Course.

see58. For students wishing to follow a one-year Preparatory Course in English or German with a quota there is an additional year of study. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation.

see59. There is a one-year Russian Preparatory Course.

see60. For the 2005-2006 academic year the tuition fees at İstanbul Bilgi University are 7 000 US \$. The fees will be same until the students have been graduated. (Value Added Tax (VAT) included.) The language of instruction is English and it is compulsory. Those who take the English Proficiency Test organized by the University or obtain an acceptable score in one of the international examinations (TOEFL, TWE or IELTS) recognized by the University, are eligible to register into the first year of the higher education program. Those who do not pass, follow an intensive English Course of the Foreign Languages Preparatory Department of the University. Students who then pass the English Proficiency Test register into the program of higher education which they have been placed into. This Preparatory Year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Accommodation facilities are available for boys and girls.

see61. The İstanbul Kültür University was established by the Education Foundation of the Kültür High School and instruction is given at Şirinevler-Ataköy Campuses. In the 2005-2006 academic year tuition fees are, for the Faculty of Sciences and Arts, Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences, Faculty of Fine Arts and Design 6 600 US \$, for the Faculty of Law 7 425 US \$, for the Faculty of Engineering-Architecture 7 700 US \$ and for the Preparatory Course 6 600 US \$ equal to Turkish Liras plus VAT (Value Added Tax) for all fees.

Students must get 550 points in TOEFL Examination in order to commence their studies in English Programs and have sufficient knowledge of Turkish in order to commence their studies in Turkish Programs. Those who have insufficient knowledge of Turkish and English, must follow the Preparatory Courses.

see62. Students who want to be exempted from the Preparatory Course and to be registered into the first year of their studies, must pass an examination recognized by the University; that is, TOEFL 520 and TWE 3,5, IELTS 5,5 or FCE B.

see63. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Koç University are 12 500 US \$.

see64. To be successful in this program, dexterity of the hands and fingers is essential.

see65. The language of instruction is English. The Preparatory Course offered by the Basic English Department of the Foreign Languages School of METU covers at most a period of two semesters. Those who are unsuccessful in the Preparatory Course after a year, start a course in English in Summer School. At the end of the Summer School's Course or at the end of the academic year, students take the English Proficiency Test. The stipulations for the attendance of the Course and the entrance of the examination are determined by the Department Council.

The students who are unsuccessful in the Examination held at the end of the academic year and/or Summer Course, may enter the Proficiency Test at the start of the next academic year.

The students who are unsuccessful in the Preparatory Course, may follow a Supporting Course in the next year or enter the Proficiency Test at the start of the other following year. The stipulations for the attendance of the course and the entrance of the examination are determined by the Department Council.

Students who have been unsuccessful after one year of study in the Basic English Department and accepted again at METU on the results of the Examination for Foreign Students or International Examination may follow the Supporting Class or enter the Proficiency Test at the beginning of the following academic year. The stipulations for the attendance of the Supporting Class and the entrance of the Proficiency Test are determined by the Department Council.

Students who have been unsuccessful after two years of study in this department and placed again at METU on the results of the Examination for Foreign Students or International Examination may not repeat the Preparatory Course. These students are given the space of one year in which to pass the English Proficiency Test organized by the University, or one of the international examinations (TOEFL, IELTS, CPE, CAE or FCE) (within the last two years) recognized by the University as being equivalent.

Equivalencies of these examinations are valid for a period of two years. Students who are successful in any one of the exami-

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nations may register into the department in which they have been placed, otherwise they are dismissed. Those who, for the last two academic years, are successful in the Preparatory Course or pass the English Proficiency Test or study undergraduate program of METU, are exempt from the Preparatory Course.

see66. At Sabancı University, tuition fees have to be paid. For the academic year 2004-2005, students at Sabancı University paid, for all programs, a fee of 11 000 US \$, Value Added Tax (VAT) included. The tuition fees for the 2005-2006 academic year will be determined in January 2005 by the University Council. The tuition fee is payable in two equal installments. The first payment will be made at registration for the first semester according to the official exchange rate of the Central Bank of the Republic of Turkey on August 15th, 2005. The second payment will be made at registration for the second semester according to the official exchange rate of the Central Bank of the Republic of Turkey on January 15th, 2006.

The language of instruction is English. All students who have been registered are required to pass a Proficiency Test. Those who do not attain the level required by the University in the Proficiency Test follow a one-year Basic Development Program. Students who are unsuccessful in this program are required to attend the Summer School and take the Examination again. Students who are unsuccessful at the end of the academic year or Summer School, may take the Proficiency Test at the beginning of the next academic year with the new students who have been registered into these programs. Those who are still unsuccessful cannot enter the course again but are allowed one year to work on their own and then enter the Qualification Test at the beginning of the next academic year with the new students who have been registered into the programs. The students who are still not successful, are dismissed from the University.

The students who are unsuccessful in the Basic Development Program for a semester or a year and the new students who have been placed into the programs by YÖS, are not required to attend the Basic Development program. These students may take the Proficiency Test at the beginning of the academic year in which they have been accepted or at the beginning of the next academic year. The students who are unsuccessful in the tests, have not been registered into the programs which they have been placed into.

Engineering and Natural Sciences Programs; Computer Science and Engineering, Biological Sciences and Bioengineering, Materials Sciences and Engineering, Mechatronic Engineering, Microelectronic Engineering, Telecommunication Engineering and Production Systems Engineering lead to Bachelor Degrees, Art and Social Science Programs: Visual Arts and Visual Communication Design, Cultural Studies, Community and Political Sciences lead to Bachelor Degrees, Economy-Administration Sciences Programs: Economy, Administration Sciences lead to Bachelor Degrees. Students are required to indicate programs they are interested in during the registration period. The field of the program which the students wish to commence their studies will be determined at the end of the second academic year.

see67. In this program all students are required to study German and/or English as their foreign language.

see68. For the 2005-2006 academic year, at Yeditepe University tuition fees are as follows: for the Faculty of Medicine 21 500 000 000 Turkish Liras, for the Faculty of Dentistry 26 500 000 000 Turkish Liras, for the Faculty of Engineering-Architecture and the Faculty of Pharmacy 16 500 000 000 Turkish Liras and for the Preparatory Course and the other Faculties 13 000 000 000 Turkish Liras.

see69. The language of instruction is English and Turkish. There is a one-year English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Students who pass the English Proficiency Test organized by the University or obtain an acceptable score in one of the international examinations (TOEFL) recognized by the University, are eligible to register into the first year of the higher education program into which they have been placed.

see70. The language of instruction is English. There is a one-year compulsory English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. At the beginning of the academic year, students who are successful in the English Proficiency Test or obtain an acceptable score in a TOEFL Examination register directly into the higher education program into which they have been placed.

see71. There is a one-year English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. At the beginning of the academic year, students who are successful in the English Proficiency Test or have obtained an acceptable score in one of the TOEFL, CAE, IELTS, FCE or CPE examinations (within the last two years) register directly into the higher education program into which they have been placed.

see72. The EMU is located in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, Gazimagusa (Famagusta). It is a state/trust-endowed University. The tuition fee for the academic year 2005-2006 is 4 044 US \$. This fee includes VAT and contribution to 'Student Activities Fund'. The tuition fee is payable in two equal installments at the beginning of every academic semester. Partial exemption from the tuition fee is granted to those students who achieve a minimum CGPA of 3.00 and a minimum GPA of 3.50 in a given semester.

Various accommodation facilities are available to students on and off campus. Newly registered students are given priority in EMU accommodation. The accommodation fees range from 350 - 1 000 US \$ per person for one semester depending on the accommodation options such as a single/double room, a studio or an apartment. The students are required to pay the accommodation fees during the registration period of each semester.

see73. The medium of instruction is Turkish. Students enrolling in this program are exempted from the English Preparatory Course.

see74. There is a one-year compulsory English or German or French Preparatory Course. Those who pass the compulsory Foreign Language Proficiency Test are eligible to register into the first year of the program into which they have been placed.

Starting with the 5th semester, a quota of fifteen students will, in accordance with the regulations of the University, be able to follow a secondary program in the field of Literature for Children and Young People.

see75. The students will continue their studies in the Meram Medicine Faculty, Selçuk University.

see76. There is a one-year compulsory English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. At the beginning of the academic year, students who are successful in the English Proficiency Test or obtain an acceptable score in one of the examinations such as TOEFL, TWE, IELTS, FCE or CPE (within the last two years) are exempted from the Preparatory Course and register directly into the program which they have been accepted into.

see77. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Kadir Has University are as follows: for the Faculty of Sciences and Arts 6 000 US \$, for the Faculty of Engineering 7 000 US \$, for the Faculty of Law, Faculty of Communication and Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences 6 000 US \$ and for the Preparatory Courses 5 000 US \$ equal to Turkish Liras. (Value Added Tax (VAT) not included.) The tuition fees can be estimated taking into consideration of the exchange rate at the start of the second semester. Decreasing and increasing of the tuition fees will be maximum 10 per cent. The tuition fees are payable in six installments, 1/4 of the tuition fees is in advance. Reduction will be 10 per cent for the advance payment. The tuition fees are paid according to the Central Bank of Republic of Turkey foreign exchange offer rate.

The knowledge of English and Turkish of the students must be sufficient or they must follow a Turkish Preparatory Course in order to follow their studies.

see78. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Çağ University are for all programs and Preparatory Courses 9 750 000 000 Turkish Liras. (Value Added Tax (VAT) not included.) The tuition fees are payable in six installments according to the agreement signed by the bank.

There is a one-year English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. The students who are successful in the English Proficiency Test set by the University or obtain an acceptable score in one of the examinations (TOEFL, IELTS) recognised by the University are eligible to register into the first year of the higher education program which they have been placed into.

The students who have been successful in the Preparatory Course may start their degree program. If they do not complete the Preparatory Course, they will be given another chance to follow the Preparatory Course for one year again. Students who are unable to be successful in this period, will be dismissed from the University.

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see79. At Yaşar University, tuition fees have to be paid. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Yaşar University for all Faculties, and the English Preparatory Course are 5 500 US \$. Value Added Tax (VAT) 8 per cent not included here, but will be added.

The tuition fee is paid in two installments, the first on registration for the first semester, the second in two installments for the second semester. The foreign exchange rate is in accord with that set down by the Central Bank of the Republic of Turkey.

The language of instruction is English for all programs.

The students who pass the English Proficiency Test organised by the English Preparatory School or obtain an acceptable score in one of the international examinations, such as TOEFL, IELTS, CPE, CAE or FCE accepted by the University Senate, may register directly into the first year of the program into which they have been placed. Students with insufficient English must follow the compulsory, one-year, intensive English program of the Wall Street Institute-Yaşar University.

The tuition and accommodation fees are determined each academic year by the University Council and will reflect the University's yearly budget and rising costs.

see80. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Girne American University for the English Preparatory Course and all Faculties are 4 200 US \$. (Value Added Tax 3 per cent (VAT) not included.) The tuition fees are payable in two equal installments. The students who have the financial straits can pay the fees in more installments according to the special agreement held with the Directorate of Accountancy Office of the University. Extra amount of 150 US \$ is paid with the first installment. This is 45 US \$ for the registration, 55 US \$ for the transportation and parking, 50 US \$ for the academic and cultural activities fees. At the start of the second academic semester 150 US \$ are paid for the same purposes. In the following semesters extra 125 US \$ are paid for the academic and cultural activities. Academic Success Scholarships are granted, to those students who achieve 10 departmental course and have a minimum CGPA of 3.00 in a given semester. The scholarships for the coming academic year are granted (50 per cent of the tuition fees) to the first three students who are successful at the end of the English Preparatory Course. At Girne American University, the reduction in tuition fees is available for the students who have got sportive activities 20 per cent - 50 per cent; for the sisters and brothers 20 per cent each; for the married couples 20 per cent and for the students who pay tuition fees in advance 10 per cent.

The students whose knowledge of English is insufficient enter the English Preparatory School. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation. Students who pass the English Proficiency Test organized by the University or obtain an acceptable score in one of the TOEFL, GCE or IELTS examinations register directly into the higher education program into which they have been placed. The English Preparatory Course includes 35 academic weeks between October 2005 - August 2006.

Various accommodation facilities are available to students, both female and male. Priority is given to newly registered students. The fees are paid monthly or yearly with a deposit depending on the accommodation options such as a single/double bed in an apartment. The accommodation agreement is held for an academic year. The students get their deposit back at the end of the academic year.

see81. The European University of Lefke is located in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus. It is a state/trust-endowed University. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees for all programs including the Preparatory School are 2 200 US \$. The fee is payable in two equal installments at the registration periods. If the fees are paid in four installments, the payment will be 2 400 US \$. (Value Added Tax %3 (VAT), contribution to Student Activities Fund, 105 US \$ for the re-registration expenses not included.)

Extensive scholarship facilities are available for the students who achieve a minimum CGPA of 2.00. Academic Performance Scholarships are granted with the amount of 200 - 1 200 US \$ to those students who are in the honour list and achieve a minimum CGPA of 3.00 for the following academic year. Scholarships are also granted to brothers and sisters who pursue their education in the Lefke Avrupa University and to the successful sportsmen. The scholarships are not granted to those students who don't achieve a minimum CGPA of 2.00. This is valid for all categories of scholarships.

Accommodation facilities are available for students on and off campus. The fees for the accommodation facilities range between 70 US \$ and 120 US \$ per month. (The fee for the food not included.)

Students who do not pass the English Proficiency Test at the registration period, follow a one-year English Preparatory Course. This year is not included in the total number of years of study required for graduation.

see82. The Ulusallararası Kıbrıs University is located in Lefkoşa City. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees are for the English Preparatory School and for the Faculties 4 000 US \$ (Value Added Tax (VAT) 3 per cent, for the registration, and Student Activities Fund, 250 US \$ are not included.) 200 US \$ is paid on registration every year. The tuition fees are payable in two installments at the registration period and at the start of the second semester. Detailed information about this can be obtained from the Directorate of Registration and Student Affairs Office.

Academic Performance Scholarships are granted to those students who achieve a successful performance for the following semester. Scholarships are also offered for the students who have got outstanding sportive achievements and cultural activities. The tuition fees for the sisters and brothers and for the sons and daughters of the teachers are reducible. Two scholarships may be granted to the students at the same time. Scholarships are not granted to those students who do not achieve a minimum CGPA 2.50. All detailed information about this can be obtained from the Directorate of Registration and Student Affairs Office.

The language of instruction is English except Turkish Languages and Literature Program. For students who do not pass the English Proficiency Test at the registration period, there is a one-year English Preparatory Course. The students must pass the English Proficiency Test organised by the Preparatory School or have obtained an acceptable score in one of the international examinations TOEFL or GCE (within the last three years) recognized by the University. Those who do not pass, must follow an English Preparatory Course for a year and pass the English Proficiency Test. An academic year includes two semesters.

Modern accommodation facilities are available for students both male and female. The charge for the single-room is 800 US \$, for the double-room is 550 US \$, for the four-room it is 350 US \$ per person in a semester. (Food, electricity, telephone and water are not included.) The fees are paid at the beginning of the semester with a deposit of 150 US \$ for once. Students can get their deposit back when they leave dormitory. A reasonable price for tuition, registration, course registration, students activities fund, transportation, food and the Preparatory School books can be offered for the students who live at the dormitories. Detailed information about this can be obtained from the Directorate of Registration and Student Affairs Office.

see83. For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at Yakın Doğu University for the English Preparatory Course and all programs are 2 500 US \$ (Value Added Tax %3 (VAT), 77 US \$ for the registration, 50 US \$ for the Student Activities Fund fees not included.) The tuition fees are paid in two installments at the registration period and at the start of the second semester.

Academic success scholarships are granted to those students who achieve a minimum 4.00 according to the credit system of the University. The accommodation fees vary from 500 - 1 500 US \$ per person for one semester depending on the accommodation options such as a single/double/four room for the 2005-2006 academic year.

see84. For the Interpretation and Translation (Turkish-French) Program, students, if they wish, can follow a double language program in their third and fourth years on condition that their level of English or German is adequate. They will then be granted a double language diploma.

For the Interpretation and Translation (Turkish-English) Program, students, if they wish, can follow a double language program in their third and fourth years on condition that their level of French or German is adequate. They will then be granted a double language diploma.

see85. The students who are registered in this program, commence their studies at the University in the first year and in the following years commence and complete their studies in the ships and hotels of the University.

INFORMATION CONCERNING THE HIGHER EDUCATION PROGRAMS THAT ACCEPT FOREIGN STUDENTS

- see86.** At Okan University tuition fees have to be paid. For the 2005-2006 academic year the tuition fees are for the Preparatory Course 4 000 US \$, for the Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences, and for the Faculty of Science and Arts 6 000 US \$, for the School of Computer Studies and Tourism 4 000 US \$ equal to Turkish Liras. The 8 per cent Value Added Tax (VAT) is not included but will be added.
- see87.** There is a one-year Preparatory Course in German, French or English for students wishing to follow it. This year is not included in the total number of years required for graduation.

- see89.** There is a one-year Preparatory Course in Japanese. This year is not included in the total number of years required for graduation. The students who are successful in the Proficiency Test may register directly into the program which they have been accepted into.

- see91.** The language of instruction for many vocational courses is in Turkish, but it is English for many of the optional and some of the compulsory courses.
- see92.** For the 2005-2006 academic year, the tuition fees at TOBB Economy and Technology University are 6 500 US \$. The language of instruction is Turkish. There is a one-year compulsory English Preparatory Course. Students must have the knowledge of Turkish to commence their studies or have a certificate in Turkish from TÖMER.
- see93.** METU Northern Cyprus Campus is located 5 km north of Guzelyurt. The instruction of NCC programs will begin for the 2005-2006 academic year. Various adequate accommodation facilities are available to students in this modern campus which is one hour far from Lefkoşa. The language of instruction is English. The students who are donated with the quality education by the academic staff of METU are offered the diploma at the international level. The annual tuition fees are 4 300 US \$, for all programs and the Preparatory Course.
